

Dee's watercolor painting selected for art show

"Another 4020 Evening," a watercolor painting by Nancy Dee of Haxtun, has been juried into the 22nd Annual Colorado Watercolor Society State Exhibition March 2-24, hosted by Foothills Art Center in Golden.

Last year's exhibition drew visitors from across the state, as well as local media. This year, Foothills' newly-renovated galleries will display 92 exciting works in the watercolor medium, selected by world-renowned juror, Thomas W. Schaller.

"Just getting into the show is an honor," said Dee of her selected painting. Not only will her piece be on display, Dee will also be doing a demo at the show on Saturday, March 16.

He holds Signature Member status at both the American Watercolor Society and National Watercolor Society and is featured in many national and international publications. Schaller has also authored two well-known books, "Architecture in Watercolor" and "The Art of Architectural Drawing."
