Action taken on 2 ordinances

Two ordinances were introduced and approved on the first reading at Tuesday's meeting. One ordinance addresses limitations to open burns within city limits, and the other adds language to an existing municipal code that restricts the size and location of signs in town.

The ordinance makes it unlawful for any person to burn any sweeping, trash, lumber, leaves, straw, papers, grass or other combustible material in any street, alley, yard or on any lot within city limits without a permit.
