

Calving workshop scheduled for Feb. 1

A calving workshop will be held at the concession building at the Yuma County Fairgrounds in Yuma Tuesday, Feb. 1 at 6 p.m.

Dr. Robert Mortimer will present "Handling Calving Difficulties." Mortimer is a DVM and associate professor with the Veterinary College at Colorado State University. The workshop will discuss normal vs. abnormal calvings, signs of calving and how to manage a difficult birth.

A chili soup supper will be served at 6 p.m. followed by the program at 6:30 p.m.
