Dragon pitchers combined to hold the Tigers to just 12 hits in 12 innings. Meanwhile, Holyoke knocked in 20 runs on 19 hits in the doubleheader to hold on for the victories.

In the first game of the doubleheader, five Dragons had multiple hits as HHS coasted to a five-inning 17-3 win. Holyoke's offensive surge piqued in the third inning as eight of the nine players to step to the plate rounded the bases to score, some more than once.
