Holyoke High School senior Meg Strauss was recently awarded the Daniels Scholarship.

She is one of approximately 250 new Daniels Scholars this year to be selected from the rigorous application, interview and selection process.

The Daniels Scholarship Program does not offer “full-ride” scholarships; instead, they are “last-dollar” scholarships intended to cover the student’s unmet financial need, including required college expenses, tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, and miscellaneous educational expenses.

The scholarship can be used at any college in the nation and is used for all four years of schooling.

Strauss plans to use the scholarship at CSU in Fort Collins, where she will be studying history education and political science.
