—Anastasia Conklin and Dani Brandt, who placed first place gold for their interpersonal communications project, “Breaking Barriers: Teens and Elders.”

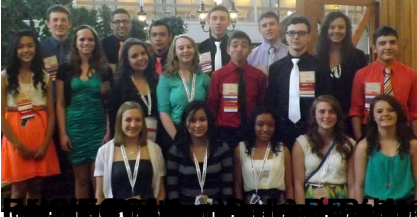
