

Country Christmas is Monday

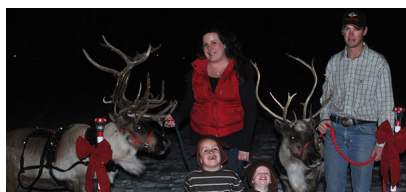
